1. Less than 18
2. Above 65 years of age
3. Wt less than 45 kg
4. Interval <3 months (males) Interval <4 months (females)
5. Hb<12.5gm%
5. Alcohol intoxication
6. Fever
7. Antibiotics 15 days
8. Received blood in last 12 months
9. On Tb. Aspirin 3 days for Platelets
10. Dental extraction in last 6 months
11. Major Surgery in last 12 months
12. Malaria in last 3 months
13. Tatoo in last 12 months
14. Ongoing pregnancy, lactation, Menstrual periods.
15. Dengue, Chikungunya in last 6 months
16. Body piercing in last 12 months
17. Tuberculosis in last 2 years
18. *Immunization*
- a. Measles mumps tetanus typhoid yellow fever in last 15 days
- b. Rabies (dog bite) in last 1 year
